

GRIEVANCES REGARDING UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS/INTERNAL EVALUATION

The past experience in this Institute has shown that there have been no grievances pertaining to the examinations, conduct, evaluation or results. However, in cases the performances of the students, if felt has been below par, the re-examinations are ordered by the Dean or the Principal after analysing the results and interviewing the students for the low or declined performance in a particular subject or in general. This leads to additional efforts planned for the students and leaves no opportunities for any grievances. The examination conduct and pattern are fair and transparent for students to seek clarification at any level. No revaluations have been requested to university, at least in last five years.
