INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CELL

Institute of Aerospace Medicine, IAF is a defense Institute. There is no International Student Cell in the Institute. However, the MD program is offered to the military Medical Officers of friendly Foreign Countries (FFC) as Priority -II candidates under the aegis of the office of Directorate General Armed Forces Medical services, New Delhi. The students from these Foreign Countries apply through their embassies to the Ministry of External Affairs who, in turn accept students through Ministry of Defence (O/o DGAFMS).

The Institute has had only 02 foreign students till date for the MD Aerospace medicine Program. Both the students were from Afghanistan.

The other medical courses offered to the FFC are Aviation Psychiatry Course, Primary Aviation Medicine Course 7 Aircraft Accident Pathology Course and Operational Training In Aerospace Medicine (OPTRAM) under Directorate of Training (Air Headquarters). The detailment of such Foreign Trainees is sole prerogative of Air Headquarters under Ministry of Defence in liaison with Ministry of External Affairs.
