

STUDENT COUNCIL

Institute of Aerospace Medicine is a Defense Institute and most of the faculty and the Residents / Course Trainees are Uniformed Officers, there is no provision of Student Council within the Institute. The academics are governed in accordance with the stipulations laid down by the Armed Forces Medical Services / Air Headquarters, National Medical Commission (NMC - Erstwhile MCI) and Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences. The administration of the Institute is directly under the control of Headquarters Training Command IAF and Air Headquarters with an Officer of the rank of Air Commodore being the Commandant of the Institute. The administration is governed by the Defense Services Regulations and Air Force Act.

There is no provision of Student Councils / Unions for the uniformed officers across Indian Armed Forces.

There are no separate committees specifically for / by the students in the Institute.

Such a requirement is for Under Graduate Institutes (Private or Government) and as such not permitted in Defense Establishments
