(a) <u>Presidential Colours</u>. The Institute was conferred the 'Presidential Colours' on 21 Nov 05 by Dr APJ Abdul Kalam. It became the first medical unit in the three services to achieve this distinction.



(b) <u>NAAC Accreditation</u>. The Institute was graded 'A' by the National Academic Accreditation Council (NAAC) in Dec 2010 and A+ during reaccreditation in 2017 with a GPA of 3.53 (out of a maximum of 4). The NAAC team recommended the Institute for taking up the case for its recognition as an Institution of National Importance (INI), which has been taken up by the

- (c) <u>Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) Commendation</u>. The Institute was **commended by the MoCA** for its contribution to Civil Aviation in India, during the Centenary Celebrations of Civil Aviation in India.
- (d) <u>Centre of Excellence</u>. The Institute was declared as a 'Centre of Excellence' by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS) on 01 Jul 15, the first among more than 600 colleges of the University.
